



# GOA-ON and OARS Summary of the 5th Symposium for the Ocean in a High CO<sub>2</sub> World

GOA-ON and OARS were well represented at the 5th Symposium for the Ocean in a High CO2 World, held from 13.-16. September 2022 in Lima, Peru. In addition to attending the Symposium, GOA-ON members participated in the GOA-ON Regional Hubs workshop, the OARS Co-Champion workshop and the Annual GOA-ON Executive Council Meeting.

# **GOA-ON Regional Hubs Workshop**





The GOA-ON Regional Hubs Coordination Workshop, sponsored by the IAEA OA-ICC, brought together representatives from all 9 GOA-ON hubs for the first time. The <u>regional Hubs</u>, founded by researchers in the region, foster communities of practice for the efficient collection of comparable and geographically distributed data to assess ocean acidification and its effects and to support adaptation tools like model forecasts. Each Hub is supported by a member of the

GOA-ON Secretariat. There are currently regional Hubs in the Arctic, the Mediterranean, North America, the North East Atlantic, Africa, South Asia, the Pacific Islands and Territories, the Western Pacific and the Latin American and Caribbean region. The Regional Hubs came together to exchange updates, discuss activities and challenges, trainings and capacity building, plans for the future and integration with the UN Ocean Decade program OARS - Ocean Acidification Research for Sustainability.

## **GOA-ON Executive Council Meeting**

The GOA-ON Executive Council held its 7th annual in-person meeting following the Ocean in a High CO2 World Symposium. #### Presentations at the 5th Symposium for the Ocean in a High CO2 World 13. - 16. September 2022

GOA-ON members put in a strong showing at the High CO2 Symposium. Several Executive Council members were part of the International and Scientific Organizing Committees, and may took on Moderator roles throughout the Symposium. Presentations covering the six Symposium themes, split into categories, took place in five rooms over four days. Mornings started with plenary presentations, given on a variety of ocean acidification issues. A number of other EC members gave presentations in Lima, including Punyasloke Bhadury, Libby Jewett, Sam Dupont, Richard Bellerby, Adrienne Sutton, Dick Feely, Kim Currie, Agneta Frasson, and Melissa Chierici.

September 2022.

GOA-ON EC Member Dr. Kim Currie from New Zealand presented the community project on '<u>The</u> <u>development of accessible best</u> <u>practices for monitoring ocean</u> <u>acidification globally through the</u> <u>"GOA-ON in a Box" initiative</u>' (38:37) on 13. September in Room 3 during the Capacity Building and Best Practices Session of Theme F. Dr. Currie also presented on "Practical Resources and Strategies to Assist



Policymakers in Managing Ocean Acidification."



GOA-ON co-chair and OARS co-lead Prof. Steve Widdicombe gave the Plenary Presentation on 14. September 2022, with the title "<u>Ocean Acidification Research for Sustainability (OARS) -</u> <u>Where did it come from? What is it? How can I be involved?</u>" (4:10) The presentations introduced the GOA-ON led UN Ocean Decade programme <u>OARS</u> and the seven OARS Outcomes. Each of the Outcomes is represented by a team of co-champions and a working group. OARS invites community members and interested individuals to join the programme and deliver the ocean acidification research we need for the ocean we want!
